Leicester Council give green light to £1.1 million go-kart track after planning permission was granted.

Leicester City is set to get a new leisure activity that's sure to get residents and visitors racing to visit. The City's Council has granted TeamSport Indoor Karting the go ahead to open a centre at New Star Road, North East of the City.

The state of the art indoor centre will feature a multi-level circuit complete with customer facilities including a kids party room and licenced bar.

TeamSport, who has a proven track record of opening and operating successful indoor karting venues, expects the new site to create up to 30 jobs, a mix of both full and part time roles many of which may appeal to younger people and students.

An industrial unit on New Star Road, which has been vacant for approximately a year and previously occupied by Wolsey Clothing, will provide motor enthusiasts and thrill seekers with a 500m professionally designed circuit complete with hair raising bends, exhilarating long straights and jaw dropping ramps for up to 16 karters to race around at any one time.

Dominic Gaynor, Managing Director of TeamSport Karting said; "We're delighted with the decision from the Council. The location is great, close to the city and just off the ring road making access easy for both residents and visitors to the city. We're looking forward to adding karting to the list of leisure activities available in the area when the track opens in November."

TeamSport Karting Leicester will be the company's 27th centre across the UK and promises a karting circuit like no other. This unique venue will offer:

- State of the art venue with free parking and full spectator area
- 500m multilevel circuit for up to 16 karters at one time.
- Professional race wear, full safety briefings and tuition.
- Year-round karting for all, with karts for racers as young as eight years old
- Licensed Fuel Bar for drinks and food
