**Hull City Council give green light to £1.1m go-kart track after planning permission was granted.**

A new indoor leisure activity that's sure to get residents and visitors racing to visit has been approved by the City's Council. TeamSport Indoor Karting has been granted the go ahead to open a centre on Freightliner Road, west of the City.

The state of the art indoor centre will feature a multi-level circuit complete with customer facilities including a kids party room, spectator areas and licensed bar.

TeamSport, the UK's largest indoor karting operator, who has a proven track record of operating successful indoor karting venues across the country, expects the new site to create up to 30 jobs, a mix of both full and part time roles many of which may appeal to younger people and students.

Extensive work will be undertaken by the landlord of the 30,000sq ft industrial unit on Freightliner Road before TeamSport will gain access to commence the build of their multi-level track. Once complete the centre will provide motor enthusiasts and thrill seekers with a 500m professionally designed circuit complete with hair raising bends, exhilarating long straights and jaw dropping ramps for up to 16 karters to race around at any one time.

Dominic Gaynor, Managing Director of TeamSport Indoor Karting said; "We're delighted with the decision from Hull's Council. The city is undergoing a huge programme of regeneration and our chosen location will bring back to life a now derelict unit as well as providing a range of job opportunities for local residents.

We hope that the initial work on the building will start in the new year so that we can open around Autumn 2019".

TeamSport Karting Hull promises a karting circuit like no other. This unique venue will offer:

- State of the art venue with free parking and full spectator area.
- 500m multilevel circuit for up to 16 karters at one time.
- Professional race wear, full safety briefings and tuition.
- Year-round karting for all, with karts for racers as young as eight years old
- Licensed Fuel Bar for drinks and food
- Modern meeting facilities for corporate clients
- Cadet Academy programme that provides tuition for younger karters
